SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20TH, 2019, 9am-4pm

This event is open to Hudson City School District student, grades 5-12. Grades 5-8 must paint with a partner. Groups of 2 only. Grades 9-12 may paint solo or with a partner. One window per student.

REGISTRATION STEPS:

- 1. SCHOOLS: <u>Between Sept. 26 to Oct. 8.</u> Artist(s) submit artwork to his/her school—High School Office, Middle School Resource Center, or East Woods Art Teacher. Include BOTH names, grades, emails, and phone #s on back of the artwork.
- 2. ONLINE: ONE artist registers their team and submits \$24 fee online at: <u>www.HudsonPTO.org</u> Online registration opens at **5am on Sept. 26.**

BOTH steps must be completed by Oct. 8, 2019 for window assignment

Artwork:

- All artwork shall be submitted in full color on 8 ½ x 11 unlined white paper. Both partners names, grades, emails, and phone #'s on back.
- Artwork must be family friendly Halloween/Autumn designs. Work submitted with inappropriate gore, religious iconography, names, etc. will not be accepted at the discretion of the Event Chairperson.

Registration:

- Online registration form to be completed by **ONE** partner who will register both students and pay the \$24 window fee online. Go to <u>www.HudsonPTO.org</u> and click Windows link to register. **Registration opens at 5 am**
- All communication is via email.
- Windows assignments and other details will be posted online on Thursday, October 17.

Day of Painting:

- Artists will be assigned a check in for your window's designated area. At check in, artists will receive paint, brushes, drop cloths, and original artwork. A parent must be present at check in.
- Additional supplies to bring: small/large brushes, garbage bag, paper towels, water, bucket/sponges/ plastic cups, paint mixing bowls/plates, tape, newspaper, dry erase marker, etc.
- One parent per window is required for adequate supervision of students

The 1st 150 paid registrants will be guaranteed a window and tshirt for each artist. Artwork and payment received after 150 will be placed in a lottery for remaining windows. Registration opens at 5am on Sept 26.
